International Meeting in Halle

The 6th international project meeting was held at BFW Halle in Germany on 20-22 April 2009. The main topic at the meeting was the development within the project e-Vision55plus.

Within months of intensive work the partners of the project have developed four information modules. Within the next months all modules will be translated into each partner's language, tested with participants and made available to the public step-by-step.

- ◆ Daily Living Skills
- ◆ Computer
- ◆ Internet

Interviews with project participants

Interviews were carried out with persons being interested in participating in the project. The purpose of these interviews were to get an overview on their vision loss and their ability and interests in the computer and internet.

54 interviews took place in total, 28 female and 26 male persons from all partner countries. The majority of the participants were aged between 55-60 but there were also some persons up to and over 80.
